With English being the language of instruction for the vast majority of subjects at PPiP, a strong command of the English language is tantamount to the progress of your child across the curriculum. We strive to achieve this in a number of different ways, such as:

- Supporting children in their regular lessons, so that each child gets the help, or the challenged they need to progress further;
- Targeted small group or even one to one intervention sessions, both regularly timetabled and individual, devised and planned in conjunction with their classroom teacher;
- Consulting regularly with teachers, subject leads and Key Stage leads to discuss upcoming lessons and topics, provide differentiation and resources that help bridge the EAL gap.
- or are intensive EAL classes, aimed at accelerating a child's progress in English so that they can become confident and successful learners in the classroom.

The **SEN's** Department aims are not all that dissimilar: to meet the needs of each child as an individual, and help them to become happy, confident and nurtured members of the PPiP community. Our SEN staff assist parents and teachers in understanding the different ways in which their child learns. This will involve communicating closely with teachers, the school's management team and parents, as well as working with the children themselves to devise strategies, individualised education plans or seek further support. This is all tailored to the needs of the individual, so that they can develop into confident, independent learners and people.
